

Notations to the supply of 'resin' for the purpose of in-pavement sensor installation.

This notation pertains to the effects of moisture upon the resin through installation practice or development of 'moisture' within the resin container during storage, handling and transportation.

This includes the following 'resin' products:

- *Novacos NPR-12 resin and hardener*
- *Global Resins PU200 resin and hardener*

Excel Technology Co Pty Ltd (Excel) does not guarantee the site in any way if the pavement cuts / slots are 'wet-cut'. The slots must be dry-cut with a suitable and approved device and vacuum facility.

After collection for delivery of the product, Excel does not guarantee the outcome and performance of the site where resin is handled or installed by an independent party of Excel. This is due to the variations in storage and / or transportation where there is potential for moisture to develop within the sealed resin container, through such forms as condensation. Even 1-3 drops have the potential to contaminate the supply if these develop within the container / tin and can occur through transportation in the back of a truck, utility or other method, including where temperature differentials exist.
